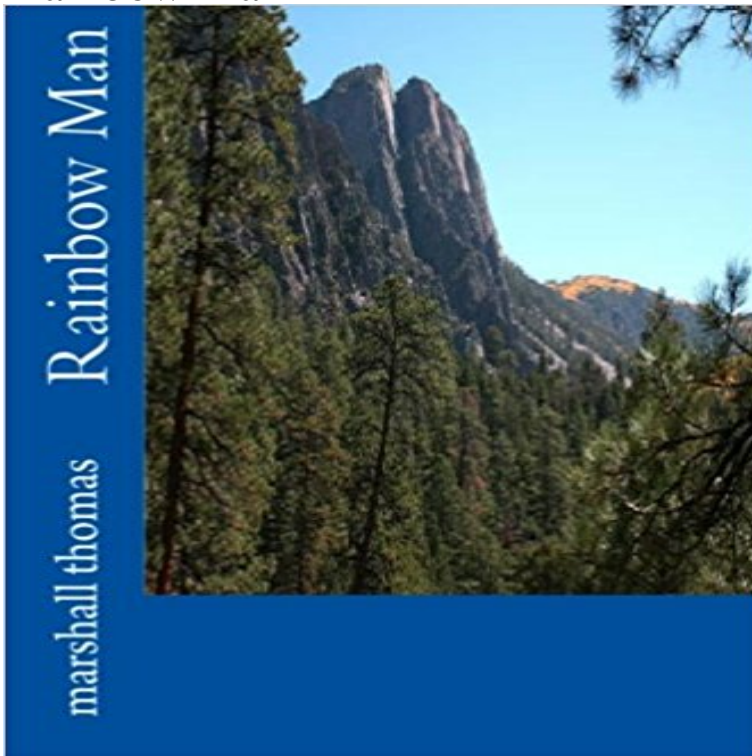


# Rainbow Man

I half mourned and half rejoiced in the spectacle and the loss.
