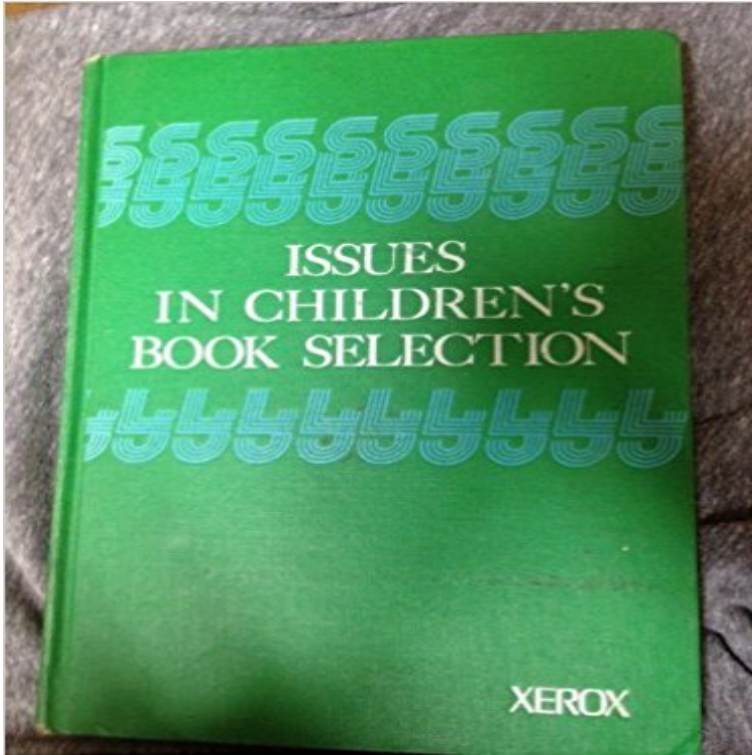


Issues in Childrens Book Selection
