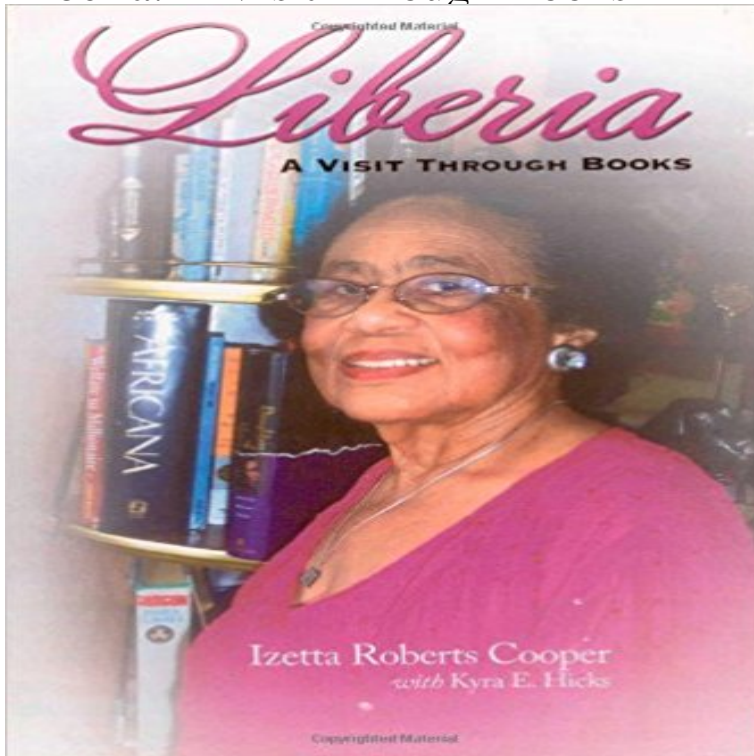


Liberia: A Visit Through Books
