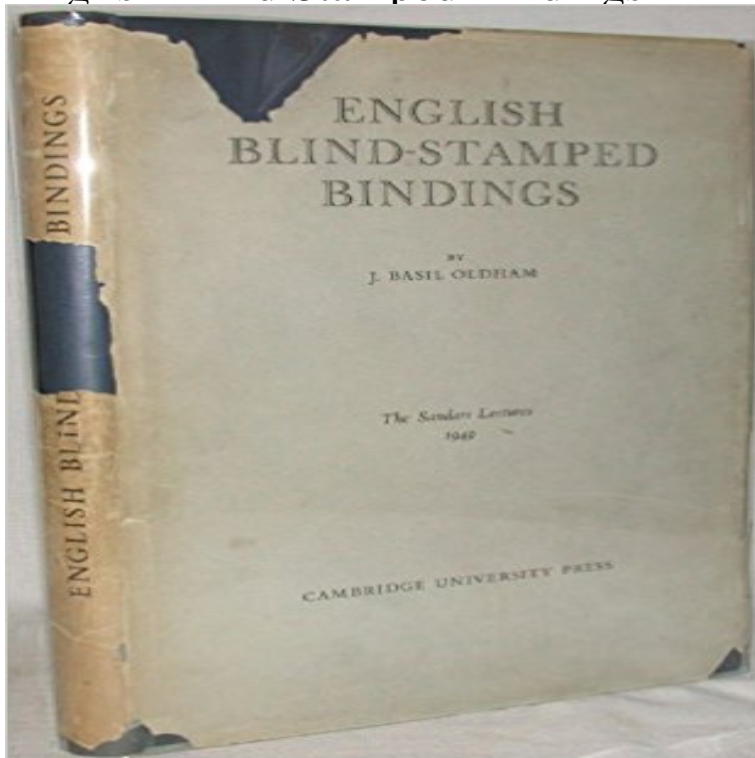


English Blind Stamped Bindings

Oldham, an authority on his subject, here describes his methods of study, and accounts for many groups of bindings that may be attributed to particular craftsmen or binderies. Oldham's experience includes all important English collections. His book devises a method of ornament-classification and description and is illustrated by 61 plates.
