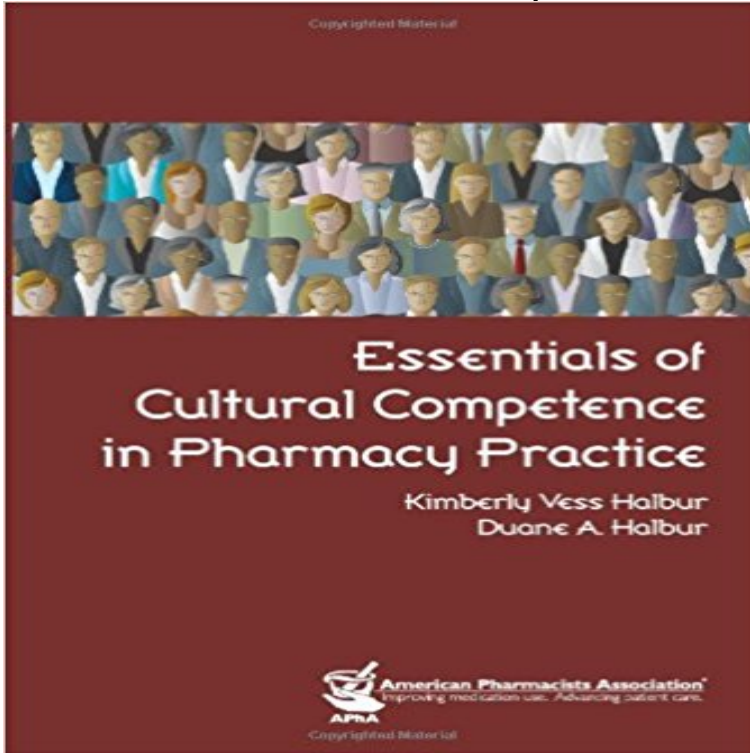


Essentials of Cultural Competence in Pharmacy Practice
