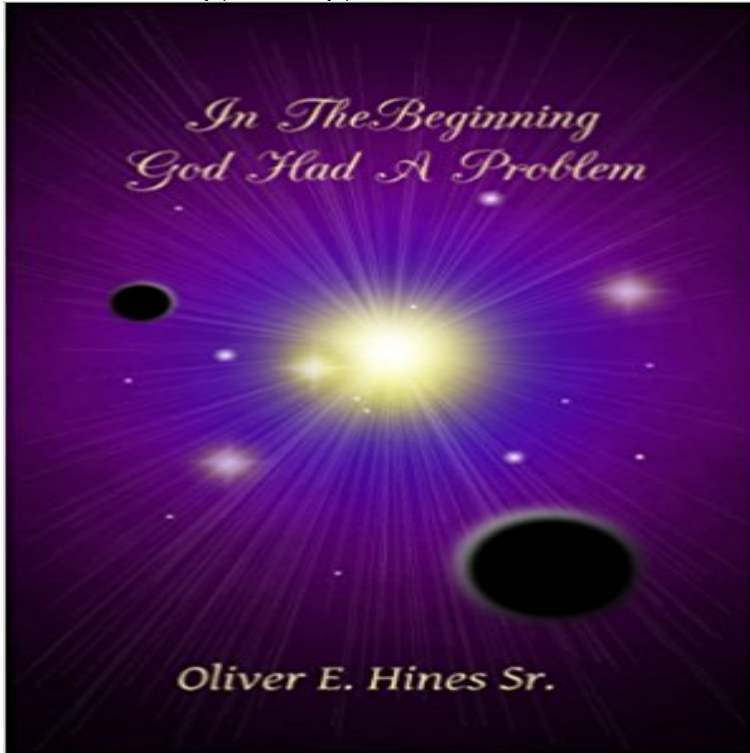


In The Beginning God Had A Problem
