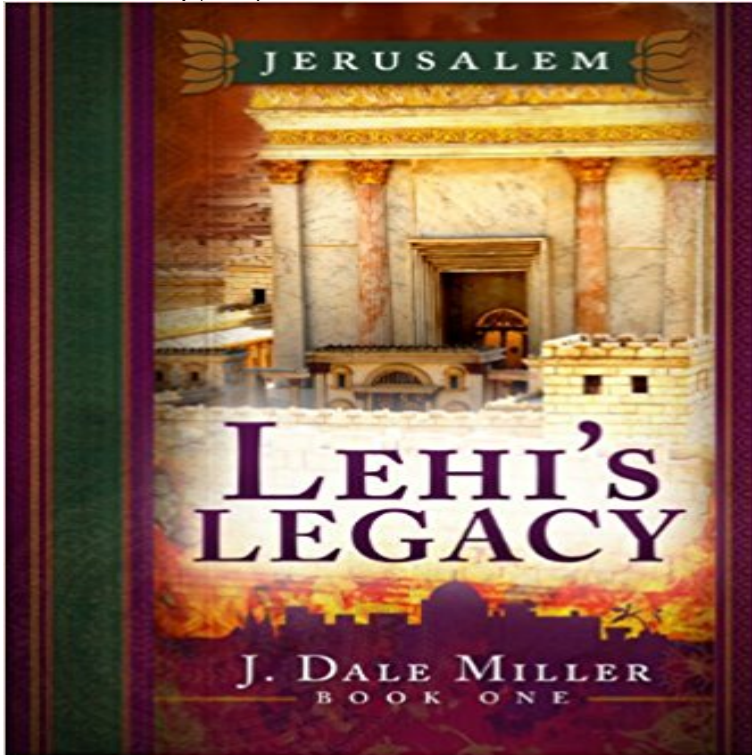


Lehis Legacy: Jerusalem
