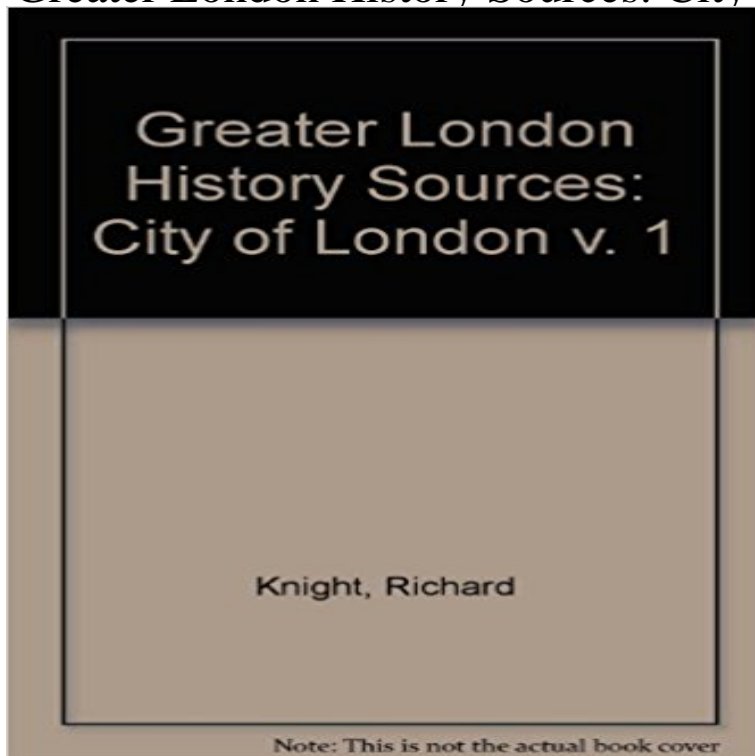


Greater London History Sources: City of London v. 1
