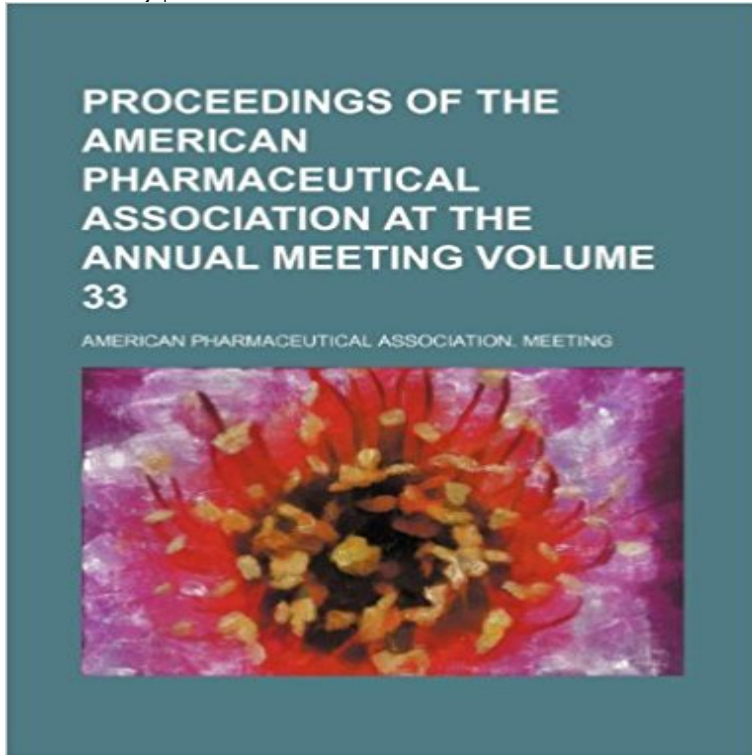

Not illustrated. 1886 Excerpt: ...to dissolve in the alkaline contents of the small intestine. The preparation being made from horn, has been named keratine. The horn shavings are digested in artificial gastric juice until all the albuminous substances capable of being dissolved out by pepsin and hydrochloric acid are removed, and then for several weeks in ammonia. The keratine is dissolved by the ammonia, and upon evaporation of the solution until only a trace of ammonia remains, a gum-like liquid is obtained, which can be used for coating pills. Dr. Unna has found that pills made with ordinary excipients are apt to swell and burst the keratine coating, and he recommends the use of an excipient consisting of charcoal, almond oil, and cacao butter. Each pill should be covered with a layer of cacao butter, and then coated two or three times with keratine. Although not soluble in hydrochloric acid, keratine is soluble to some extent in acetic and citric acids, which acids should therefore not be given at the same time as keratine coated pills.--Phar.
