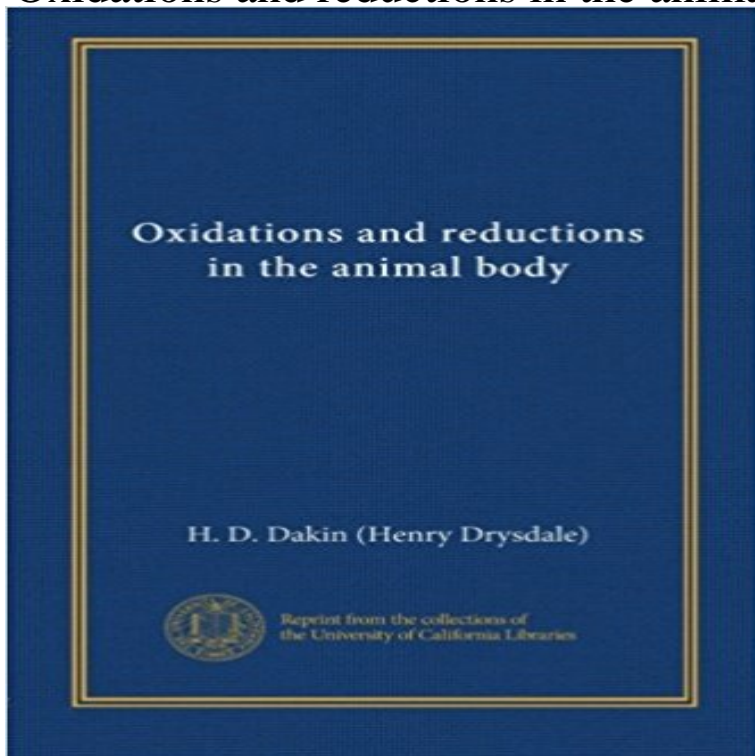


## Oxidations and reductions in the animal body
