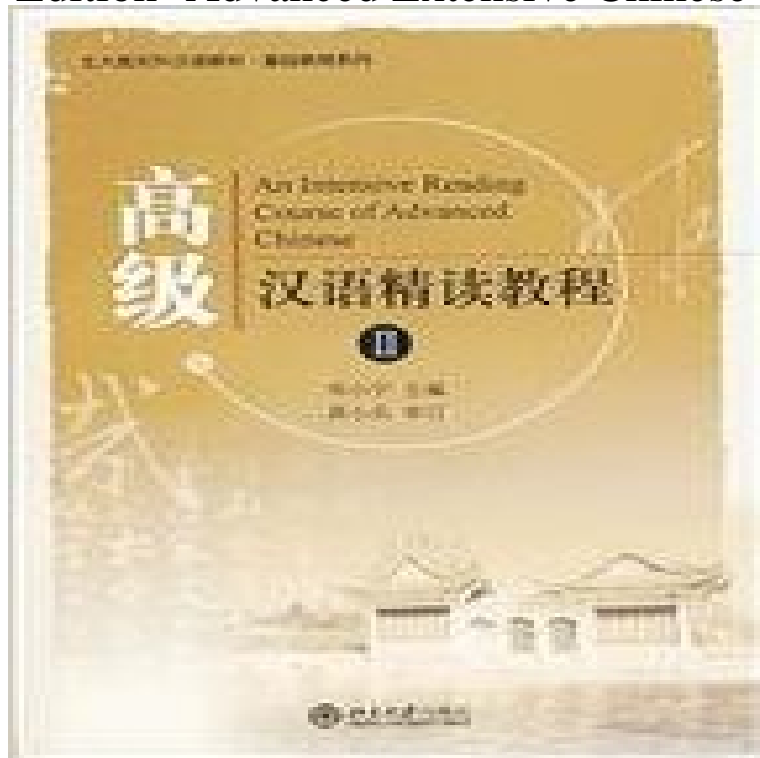


## Chinese Textbook of Advanced Studies in Long Term-Peking University Edition- Advanced Extensive Chinese Course (II) (Chinese Edition)
