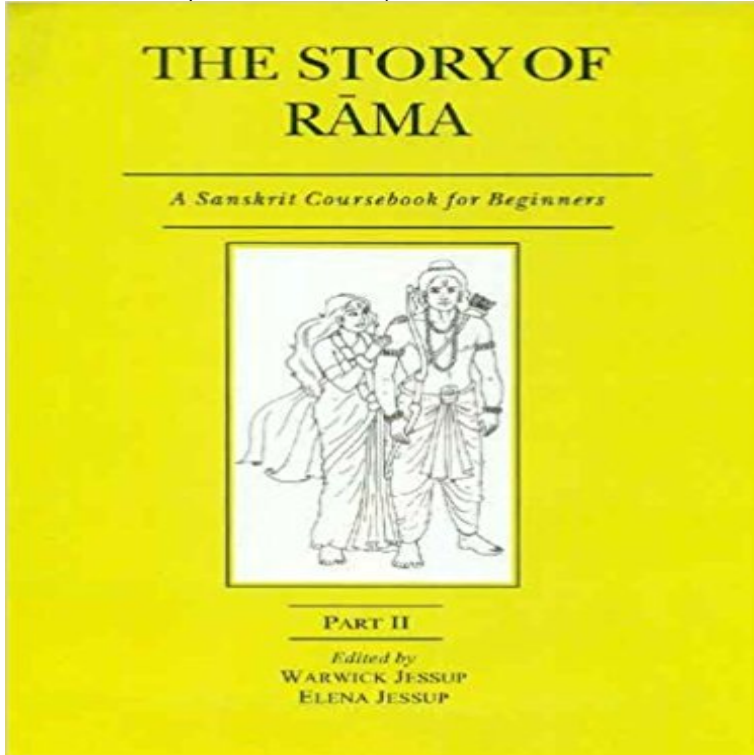


The Story of Rama, Part 2
