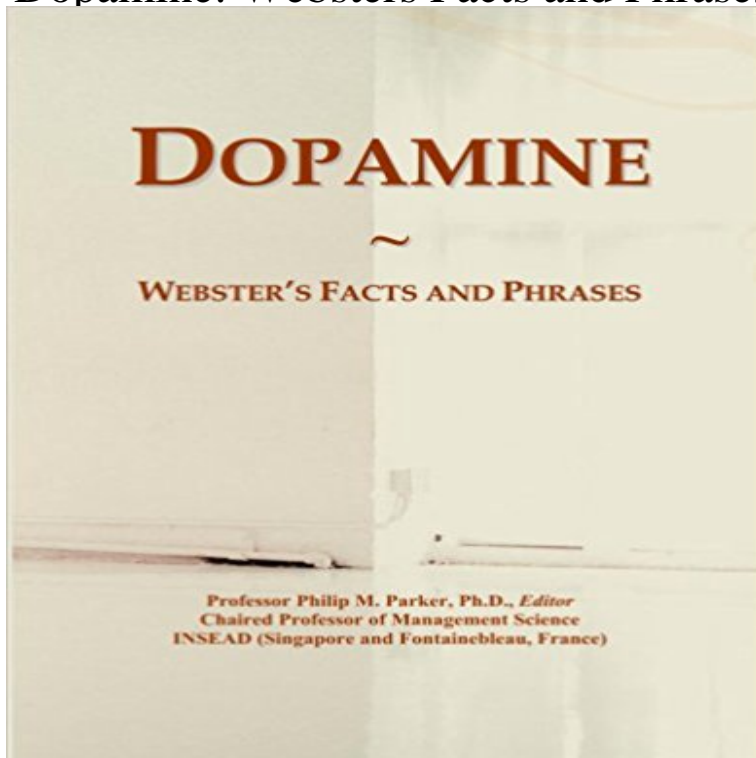


Dopamine: Websters Facts and Phrases
