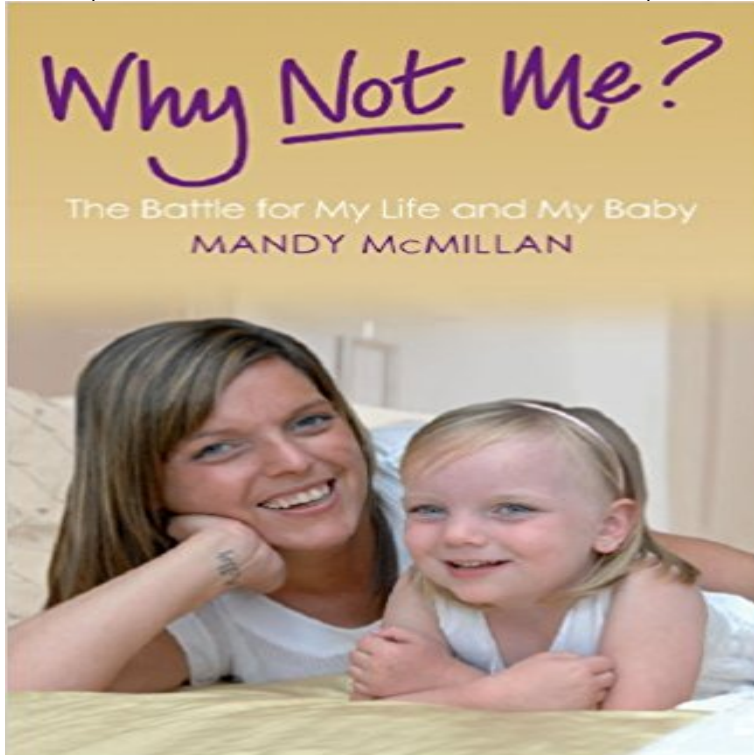


Why Not Me?: The Battle for My Life and My Baby
