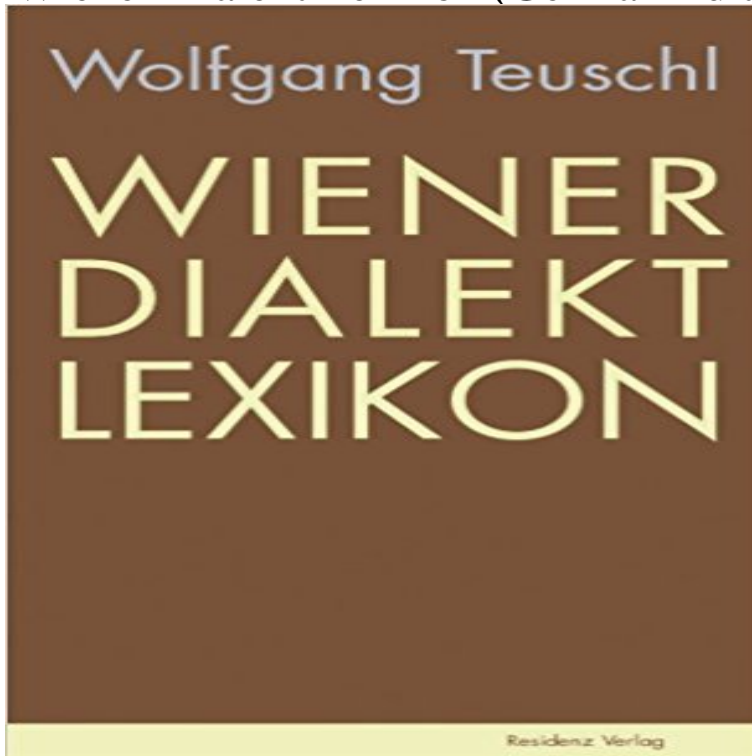


## Wiener Dialekt Lexikon (German Edition)

Vor allem aber ist dieses Buch eine höchst unterhaltsame Lektüre; wer es einmal aufschlägt, wird sich darin festlesen und aus dem Staunen und Schmunzeln nicht mehr herauskommen. So erfährt man zum Beispiel, dass scheinbar bekannte Wörter wie Pelzgeschäft oder Molkerei auch noch eine zweite, eher pikante Bedeutung haben oder dass die Wiener mehr als zwei Dutzend sprachlich äußerst kreative Möglichkeiten haben, jemandem das Götze-Zitat zu sagen. Und welcher Würstelstand-Besucher kennt sie nicht, die Standardbestellung: A Eitrigel, an Bugl und a 16er-Blech - oba dschenifa.
